Biography

Georgia Harrison: Championing Change from Reality TV to Digital Rights Advocate

Georgia Harrison is an award-winning British television personality, author, and social media content creator who first gained prominence through her appearances on *The Only Way Is Essex* (2014) and *Love Island* (2017). While she initially rose to fame through reality TV, Georgia has become a passionate advocate for online privacy and digital rights, campaigning against image-based sexual abuse and cybercrime.

Her personal experience with revenge porn propelled her into legal activism, sparking national conversations about the urgent need for

stronger legal protections. Georgia's advocacy has been recognized with awards such as Glamour's Activist Award (2023), and her memoir *Taking Back My Power* chronicles her journey to reclaim her voice and drive change.

In 2023, Georgia Harrison made her documentary debut with *Revenge Porn: Georgia vs Bear* on ITV2, a powerful exposé detailing her personal experience with image-based sexual abuse perpetrated by her ex-partner, Stephen Bear. The documentary resonated widely, raising awareness about the pervasive issue of revenge porn and establishing Harrison as a compelling advocate for victims' rights.

Building on this momentum, she followed up with the critically acclaimed two-part ITV series *Georgia Harrison: Porn, Power, Profit* in February 2025. This series expanded the conversation to include the broader online pornography industry, investigating how non-consensual content, including deepfakes, is created and monetized.

Through interviews with survivors, experts, and legal professionals, Harrison highlighted the urgent need for stronger protections against digital exploitation, cementing her reputation as a fearless storyteller and advocate for change.

Georgia Harrison's advocacy extends beyond the screen. She has actively supported Women's Refuge, participating in campaigns and events to raise awareness about online abuse and violence against women. In 2023, she was recognized by the BBC as one of the most influential women in the UK, highlighting her impact in the realm of digital rights and online safety.

Her campaigning work includes collaborations with Thames Valley Police on sexual consent initiatives, as well as engagements with The Labour Party and the Tony Blair Institute, where she has conducted interviews with leading political figures such as Keir Starmer, Tony Blair, William Hague, and Sadiq Khan.

In 2023, Georgia Harrison's courage and impact were recognized when she received Glamour's Activist Award, honoring her resilience and commitment to effecting positive change. Beyond her advocacy, Georgia has established herself as a branding powerhouse, collaborating with leading fashion and lifestyle brands and launching successful business ventures. Her genuine connection with audiences has cemented her status as a formidable presence in the realms of branding and marketing.

Georgia's transformation from reality TV star to influential advocate is detailed in her memoir, *Taking Back My Power*. Through her work on and off screen, she continues to inspire, demonstrating the power of personal transformation and the importance of standing up for digital rights in today's world.

Challenging the Legal System: The 'Intent to Cause Distress' Loophole

- Outdated revenge porn laws forced victims to prove ‘intent to harm.’
- Sharing intimate content without consent is inherently harmful – intent should never be a requirement. Many victims don't even know they've been exposed until it's too late.
- Her court case: “Not just justice for me, but a win for all survivors”.
